Pre-Access to Health Care

The **Pre-Access to Healthcare qualification** is designed to support learners to return to study and to help them develop skills needed for progression to Level 3 courses related to the vocational area of health. The qualification focuses on study skills, literacy and numeracy and personal development and includes optional units that offer learners a taste of subject areas in health that they may go on to study. Achievement of the Skills for Further Study in Health qualification will demonstrate that learners are able to study for a sustained period at an appropriate level.

You will study the following units as part of your course:

- Critical Thinking
- Essay Writing
- Introduction to Life Sciences
- Diet & Nutrition
- Eating Disorders
- Health Psychology
- Introduction to Sociology
- Equality & Diversity
- Plagiarism
- Health Promotion in Care Settings

Entry Requirements: You will need to be 16+, have GCSEs in Math's and English (Grade C or above or be willing to do them) or Functional Skill Level 2 as universities generally require these qualifications. Acceptance onto this course is subject to successful guidance interview & assessment test.

Duration: 38 weeks

Assessment: There will be a mix of continuous assessment methods including essays and case studies.
