

Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner



The aim of the **Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner** is to provide learners with the knowledge and understanding of babies and young children from birth to 7 years of age with applied knowledge in the early years, 0-5 years. The qualification content meets the Department for Education's (DfE) Level 2 full and relevant criteria for a Level 2 Early Years Practitioner in the workforce. This qualification is ideal for learners looking to work with children between birth and 5 years, and gain knowledge of working with children up to 7 years. Learners do not need to have previous experience or qualifications in working with children to undertake this qualification.

Entry Requirements: Acceptance onto this course is subject to successful guidance interview & assessment test.

Assessment: A portfolio of work is to be submitted for moderation.
