It covers everything you need to work safely and effectively, including anatomy, physiology, pathology, client care, health and safety, consultation skills, and business principles.

- Principles and practice of Complementary Therapies
- Knowledge of anatomy, physiology, and pathology relevant to Complementary Therapies
- Providing body massage for Complementary Therapies
- Providing aromatherapy for Complementary Therapies
- Providing reflexology for Complementary Therapies

This course prepares you to confidently start or develop your career in Complementary Therapies.
